Program includes two classroom visits and a follow-up class project to measure and reduce carbon footprints.



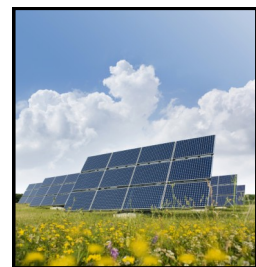
The following topics will be covered:
