Fees

- For most of the Badge programs listed here, the price is \$10/person
- Boy Scout Merit Badge programs are \$12/person
- Fishing 101 programs are \$12/person
- Night Hikes and the Night Owl badge are \$20/person
- Night Hike + Sleepovers are \$25/person
- There is a minimum of 12 attendees for each Scout program
- \$100 deposit is required to secure the date. Balance is due on day of the program
